

Conduent HCI Updates

Several data updates have been made by Conduent HCI to healthyneo.org. These include:

- The recently added demographic map, available on the Healthy Northeast Ohio home page, now has an enhanced option to view and select labels on the regional map.
- Several data indicators on healthyneo.org have been updated from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid, Feeding America, and U.S. Census Bureau Small Area Health Insurance Estimates. View all of these updated data indicators through this [custom dashboard](#).
- The Claritas Consumer Buying Power indicators of "consumer expenditures" and "percent of consumer spending" will be removed from healthyneo.org and replaced with Claritas Consumer Spending Dynamix "community expenditures" and "expenditure-to-income ratio" indicators.
