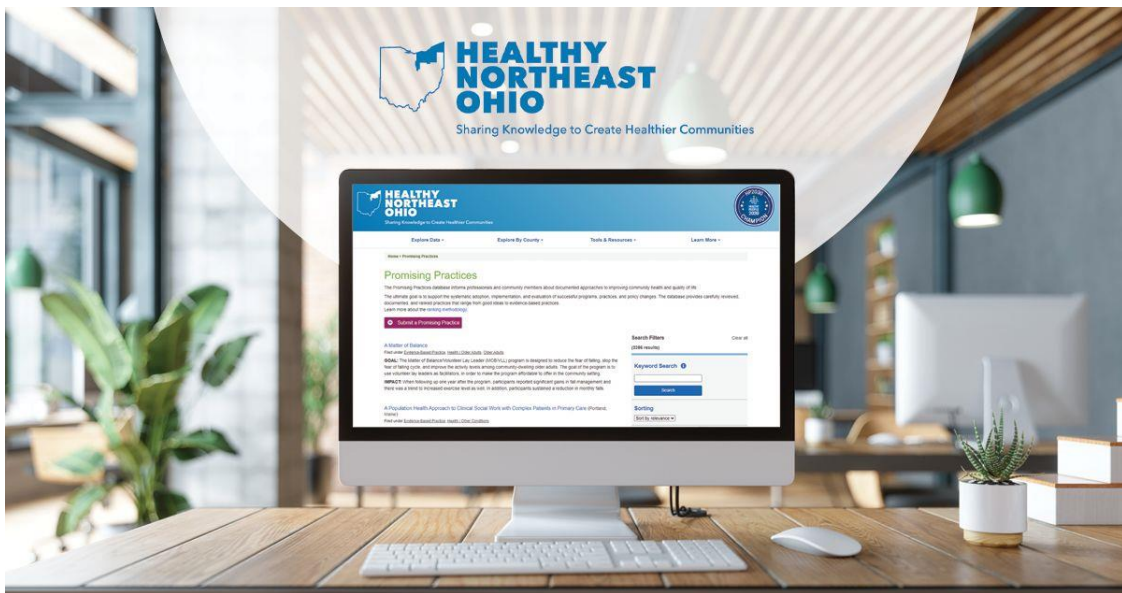
The following enhancements to existing tools and data are now available on healthyneo.org:

The Health Policy Institute of Ohio's 2023 Health Value Dashboard is now available. This tool assists with tracking Ohio's progress towards health value, by using a composite measure of population health outcomes and healthcare spending. According to the report,
